Personal Belongings

Upon starting at the nursery each child is allocated a pigeonhole for paintings, other creations and information for the parent. They also have a coat peg with their photograph and name above. This encourages independence and early observational skills in recognising both themselves and their friends.

For children in nappies Little Angels will provide Pampers nappies and Water wipes. Parents provide individual nappy creams that are labelled and put into boxes in the nappy room

We request that you name all your child's clothing, shoes, nappy bag and prams. When your child starts toilet training please send them in clothes they can easily manage themselves as this helps them to gain independence. Please send your children to nursery in clothes that are not too precious, as many of our activities involve 'messy play'. If your child does bring in personal belongings e.g. toys etc, the nursery cannot accept responsibility if they are lost or broken during the course of a busy day.

Children get distressed at losing their toys in the nursery. If your child brings a personal toy into the nursery can you please make sure that it is named. Also it is the responsibility of the Parent to put the toy in their pigeonhole before your child joins in the nursery. If your child does take the toy into nursery the parent or carer and not the staff members are to locate the toy at the end of the session.
